Medication

January's Theme: Winter and Healthy Habits

During the month we will be looking at the characteristics of Winter and all that it brings. Intermingled with winter we will also be exploring how we look after our bodies and minds to keep us healthy.

Our Character Attribute: Energetic

Geography: China and Japan

We will start off the New Year on the opposite side of the world as we explore the different traditions, foods, music and animals that make up these unique countries.

Bread and Milk Bag Collection

We are asking that families save and bring in empty usable plastic bags to your child's school. We use these for sending home wet or soiled clothing each day, and prevents messes in the children's drawstring bags. We are also collecting empty flat milk bags for the volunteers who make them into rugs for the homeless. Please continue to send these to your school for this worthwhile cause.

Interim Reports

Reports will be out to parents in February. These reports give you an idea of what development areas we are working on with your child as an individual. The teachers will be completing these throughout January. We strongly believe all children are individuals and therefore learn at different speeds and in very different ways. Combining the best of many educational theories allows our teachers to adapt the learning to suit the child, not adapt the child to suit the learning. An opportunity to discuss the reports will be available to all families.

Personal Belongings

Please ensure your child comes to school with snow pants, jackets and hats. Your child will also need **two pairs of mittens** as we don't have enough time to dry them after morning play before they go outside in the afternoon. Please **label all your children's clothing**. Many items look similar and therefore it is very difficult keeping track of whose items are whose, both for the teachers and your children. Thank you
